Meeting called to order: 6:00 pm

Jim Muenzenberger left early at 6:33 pm.

1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of December 5, 2017.
A motion was made, seconded and passed (Dr. Muenzenberger/Podszus).
2. Discussion and consideration of:
 - a. Library programs - No discussion
 - b. Recreational programs - No discussion
 - c. Website for Hartland on IATC site – update from the IATC Website Committee members – Dr. Muenzenberger will reach out to local photographer Miranda Weston to set up a meeting to look over the photos Mrs. Weston took for the Village of Hartland’s Ice Age Trail Community website. Yogerst will reach out to Lysianne Unruh and Ami Lord, the new Outreach and Education Manager for the Ice Age Trail Alliance. Yogerst will ask Ms. Unruh if she knows how many hits the Hartland Ice Age Trail Community website has received. Yogerst will call Ms. Lord to just touch base and introduce herself.
 - d. Trail signage/education – The signs with the QR codes is being produced by Sign-A –Rama. Once they are produced, they can be installed along the trail. Twelve signs were ordered. Georgson will talk to the Ice Age Trail Alliance Chapter and show them a draft of what the signs will look like. Ice Age Trail Committee members talked about installing the signs themselves.
 - e. IATC Partner Program – Pamphlet/Letter – no discussion
 - f. Kiosk update – Jack Sullivan will be presenting an update in regards to the Centennial Park Kiosk. - Jack Sullivan, Boy Scout and Eagle Scout candidate updated the committee on how his Eagle Scout project, building a Kiosk in Centennial Park, is coming along. Sullivan informed the Ice Age Trail Community Committee that he is currently working on some little details the Boy Scouts would like to see changed with his project. Boy Scouts asked for more elaborations on certain aspects of the project. This project has not been approved by the Boy Scouts. Goal is to lay concrete in the Spring and start assembling once the concrete is set. Van De Ven requested that Sullivan notify him when Sullivan is aware of the size of the bulletin boards for the Centennial Park Kiosk. Van De Ven Talk to Jeff Luetschwager from Arrowhead about the status of the Kiosk in Nixon Park. Luetschwager has the plans, materials list and will get quote for materials. Luetschwager would like to give the list of material to the where they are getting the lumber from and get a quote. Luetschwager

will ask for the materials be prepared and ready for the Village to purchase and pick it up. Yogerst will check first thing tomorrow to see if this can be done. Yogerst will talk to Village staff about when the concrete pad for the Kiosk can be poured.

- g. Discussion on installing selfie Kiosk along the Ice Age Trail - No discussion
 - h. Use of Grant money from the Ice Age Trail Alliance – Yogerst informed everyone the money is in our possession and a letter must be written describing where, when and how the money will be used in 2018.
 - i. Future Promotional Events – Discussion was about the hike the Ice Age Trail Community Committee would like to have this summer. The hike would be from Delafield to Hartland. It was suggested that the hike be brought up to the local chapter. Georgson will bring it up at the next local chapter meeting. One idea was to have the hike on National Trails Day. Georgson will also see if the local chapter would be interested in partnering up with the IATCC for this hike.
