Van De Ven brought up that Arrowhead asked for a donation that will help build their Engineering Club.
 - g. Discussion on installing selfie Kiosk along the Ice Age Trail – Jackie Perrigo will reach out to the Wisconsin Department of Tourism about where they are in their process of evaluating the Selfie stations. Wisconsin Department of Tourism was planning on evaluating the program this spring and see where new selfie stations could go.
 - h. Use of Grant money from the Ice Age Trail Alliance – Yogerst reviewed where the Grant money is being planned to be used.
 - i. Future Promotional Events –Jeannie Georgson gave an update on the different hikes that will be offered on the National Trails Day Hike from Delafield to Hartland. Yogerst will see if the Alliance can sell t-shirts on National Hike Day in Nixon Park.
