Roll Call

Meeting called to order: 6:00 pm

1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of February 15, 2018. A motion was made, seconded and passed (Dr. Muenzenberger/Podszus)
2. Discussion and consideration of:
 - a. Library programs - No Discussion
 - b. Recreational programs - Mary Wehalge will be doing Yoga in the Park on Tuesdays in the morning at Nixon Park. That way if the weather is bad they can go into the Hartland Community Center for class. Chillin on the Trail is on May 11th.
 - c. Website for Hartland on IATC site – Update from the IATC Website Committee members – The Website Committee will be meeting on a more regularly basis to go through the pictures and then add captions for each photos. Next two meetings will be held on March 9, 9:00 – 12:00 pm and March 30, 9:00 am – 11:30 am. Meetings will be held in the Village Board Room.
 - d. Trail signage/education – Muenzenberger brought in an example of the Ice Age Trail Community Website sign that went up on the Ice Age Posts through Hartland. Muenzenberger and Van Theil went around Hartland putting up the signs. *See attachment on the locations of the signs.* Muenzenberger will be ordering five more signs and placing some of them at the end of the section by the library. The extra that are not being used, will be used if a sign needs to be replaced.
 - e. IATC Partner Program – Pamphlet/Letter – No discussion.
 - f. Kiosk update – Jack Sullivan will be presenting an update in regards to the Centennial Park Kiosk. 39” W X 36” H is the size for the Bulletin Board for the Kiosk. J. Sullivan, Eagle Scout candidate, came back to report that he presented to Park Board. Sullivan reported that the concrete donation is not going to go through. Van De Ven gave Sullivan information for an individual who usually donates concrete. Sullivan stated he asked Mike Gerzewski, DPW Operation Supervisor, at the Park Board meeting on Monday, March 5, 2018, if Department of Public Works (DPW) would get the concrete and pour the slab that is needed for the Kiosk. Yogerst asked if Park Board approved of the location. Sullivan said yes. Sullivan asked if he should go to Park Board, Village Board or Ice Age Trail Community Committee for money donations for the kiosk, since the concrete donation is no longer available. Muenzenberger said that IATC doesn’t have any funds to donate for the project. Bethany Sullivan, J. Sullivan’s mom, said that if a donation falls through J. Sullivan will have to raise
